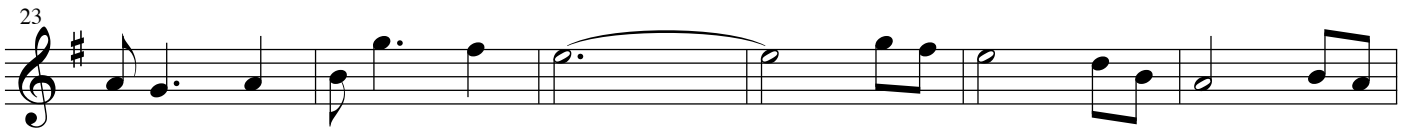


The Burial Isle

*The actual name for this island is **Inishall**, located in Loch Awe. It has been used as a burial ground for at least a thousand years, most notably as the final resting place of Dukes of Argyll of Clan Campbell, as well as nobility of clans MacNaughton and MacArthur. It also holds the ruins of the Medieval chapel of St. Fyndoca, a Scottish Martyr about whom nothing is known.
